

Windham Historic District Commission Meeting

February 4, 2009;
Rescheduled from January 28, 2009 due to snow

Commissioners present: W. McMunn, Chair; David Johnson (alt.), David Masopust, Charles Thorpe, and Nancy Ames

The meeting was called to order at 7:48 pm.

The commissioners reviewed a list of alterations and additions proposed for 28 North Road (Property #70) presented by the owner, Andrzej Walczok, and his representative, Bradford Currier. The objective of the ensuing discussion was to ensure, as plans are developed, that any changes made will be appropriate in terms of materials and appearance. The commissioners expressed their particular concern regarding a deteriorated window that has already been replaced with one that is not appropriate and will not be approved. Mr. Walczok and Mr. Currier indicated that they will submit a formal application, most likely in time for the February 25, 2009 meeting, to the Commission and that they will incorporate the Commissioners' suggestions.

The minutes of the October 29, 2008 meeting were approved. Minutes of the Commission's meetings are being posted on the Town website. Bill McMunn suggested that, in the future, Commissioners review the minutes there.

Dave Masopust reported on a meeting with CL & P regarding the possibility that new high power lines might run through the Historic District. The proposed route is an alternate and is unlikely to be selected.

The next meeting of the Windham Historic District Commission will be February 25, 2009 at 7:30 pm at the Windham Center School.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 pm.
