

Windham Historic District Commission Meeting
Windham Center School
January 25, 2012

Commissioners present: Alice Burns-Decelles, David Masopust, William McMunn (Chair), Charles Thorpe.

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Alice Burns-Decelles presented a preliminary sketch of a proposed roof extension over the entrance at the Windham Center Congregational Church, to be constructed at the same time as planned re-roofing. Also planned is the removal of a chimney that is no longer used. The commissioners discussed the features of the roof extension. An application will be submitted in time for formal review at the February meeting.

The Guidelines for Property Owners are complete and ready to be posted.

Concern was expressed about the change at Property 78 of a previously approved sign to a larger double sign without notice to or approval by the Commission.

Commissioners discussed the latest plan from Connecticut Light & Power which shows a high-voltage line passing through the Historic District as "Plan B." The consensus was that "Plan A" using the existing route through Mansfield is much more likely, and in any case, if the route through Windham Center were to be used, the cables would be buried because of the Historic District.
