

Town of Windham Historic District Commission
Regular Meeting
Windham Center Congregational Church
July 25, 2012

Commissioners and alternates present: A. Burns-Decelles, D. Johnson, D. Dupuis, D. Masopust, W. McMunn, N. Thorpe.
Also present: E. St. Germain.

Chairman McMunn called the meeting to order at 7:35 p.m.

Discussion focused on the possibility of recommending changes to the Town of Windham Planning and Zoning Commission to enable broader business use of the Windham Inn. Commissioners asked Mr. St. Germain to describe his plans for the Inn. As at previous meetings, Mr. St. Germain described a number of possibilities including a restaurant/coffee shop in the Inn and an antique shop in the house at 10 Scotland Road, which adjoins the Inn property at the rear behind the Post Office. As at previous meetings, the Commissioners asked Mr. St. Germain to put his plans in writing to give the Commission more specifics to work from in considering whether and how the zoning regulations might be changed to facilitate restoration and re-use of the Windham Inn.
