Regular Meeting
Windham Center Congregational Church
November 28, 2012

Commissioners and alternates present: A. Burns-Decelles, D. Johnson, D. Masopust, W. McMunn, N. Thorpe.

Others Present: Rev. James Beesley, Windham Center Congregational Church.

Chairman McMunn called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

There were no new applications for certificates of appropriateness.

Rev. Beesley presented two designs under consideration for the replacement door to be installed at the Windham Center Road entrance to the church. One of the designs replicated the design of the old door, with some enlargement to conform to safety codes; the other design was a plain style that did not include the distinctive trim of the first design. The decorated style of the first door is similar to the design of doors at all the other existing entrances to the main church structure.

The Commissioners unanimously agreed that despite the enlargement of the door size, the first design would be acceptable as "maintenance" and would not require a formal application for a Certificate of Appropriateness, while the second plain design, because of the change of style, would require such an application, and might not be approved. Rev. Beesley stated that with this decision, he felt that the Church would go ahead with the first design which maintains the historic style present on all the other doors.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
