Windham Historic District Commission
Commission Meeting Minutes:
April 27, 2016

The Windham Historic Commission held a commission meeting on Wednesday, April 27, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Windham Center School, 41 North Rd, Windham, CT.

In attendance: commission members Alice Burns-Decelles, Lori Guillard, and William McMunn (chair).

Also in attendance were John McGrath, Scott Clairmont (Windham Public Works Dept), Kelly Clairmont, Mike Moran, Faith Kenyon, Ellen Donahue, and Kevin Donahue.

Public Hearing called to order at 7:05 p.m.

Scott Clairmont from the Windham Public Works Dept. presented a drawing and proposal for replacing the easterly side of the Windham Upper Green roadway with a stone dust walkway, to resemble the appearance recorded in historic J. Alden Weir paintings. The town would do the work and the Pageau Trust would pay for trees and other planting. At each end of the walkway would be a stone post allowing for a car to park but not letting cars enter. The stone post would be set back to allow the Donahue's to have access to their back yard. A stone with a marker (to be determined later) would also be tastefully placed in the park area. (This to come before the commission before placement or wording).

It has been determined that with the removal of this roadway, access to the homes in that area by fire and garbage vehicles will not be affected.

Public Hearing adjourned at 8:00 p.m.

Regular Commission Meeting called to order by Chair, William McMunn.

A motion was made by Lori Guillard to approve the proposal as presented. Seconded by Alice Burns-Decelles. Motion carried unanimously. Certificate of Appropriateness will be sent out.

Next order of business was from Stephen Rouse requesting that his proposal for a solar installation be placed on hold for the time being.

Two inquires concerning repairs but these did not have to come before the Commission.

The next meeting will be on May 25th, at Windham Center School at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
