Commission Meeting Minutes  
May 25, 2016

The Windham Historic Commission held a commission meeting on Wednesday, May 25, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Windham Center School, 41 North Rd., Windham, CT.

In attendance: commission members Alice Burns-Decelles, David Masopust, William McMunn (chair) and David Dupuis (alt.) Also in attendance were Wayne Donaldson (Windham Public Schools), John Thibeault, and Bill Powers (school well committee).

Regular Commission Meeting called to order by Chair, William McMunn.

Discussion concerning the galvanized metal railing in front of the Windham Center School. The harsh look of the metal was discussed and different means to tone down the look. After much discussion Mr. Donaldson was going to look into a material called "cold galvanizing" for the railing to mute the look (i.e. grayish). He will bring back a sampling for this commission to examine.

Also discussed was the wooden fence in the front of the Windham Center School and its appearance. An accelerator product to be brushed on will allow the fence to turn gray also, blending the two fences together without such a harsh look.

Bill Powers (Well committee) stated that the artificial rock covers for the new wells have been installed, thus making a more attractive look around the well area.

Minutes of the March 30, and April 27, 2016 were approved as written.

No new applications have been received.

Next meeting will be on June 29, 2016 at the First Congregational Church of Windham, 4 Windham Center Rd. At 7:00 p.m.
