Circulation in the Adult Department rose 13% over October.

Borrowing from other network libraries rose 21%. Due to our reduced materials budget for FY 09-10, we are borrowing more materials from member libraries as we have reduced the number of titles we are able to purchase.

Use of the Internet terminals rose 8% over October; for an average of 73 persons per day.
