New Business

Magnet School 141 & 145 Tuckie Rd., Windham Center The Commission took receipt of the application for a wetlands permit for construction of water and sewer lines leading to the proposed school site, along with storm-water management on-site. After a detailed presentation from the Engineering consultants, and Soil Scientist the Commission determined that the scope of work outlined would not result in any significant impact to wetlands, and that there are no feasible or prudent alternatives to the activities as proposed.

Hain Materials Corp. 298 Windham Center Rd. This is an application for a wetlands permit for a continuation of an existing earth excavation within upland review area. The activity will remove gravel from an area that is within 200 feet of a Cedar Bog, and the Shetucket River, as well as within 100 feet from an existing man-made pond that is used for watering down the haul road. There is no activity in any wetlands, and as the Agent I have the authority to approve it, with the consent of the Board.
