**New Business**

**Ken Denning & Willimantic (Edens & Advant) LLC - Responses to violation Notice 1565 & 1589 West Main St. Willimantic** - As you may remember from the April meeting, I had sent out notices to three property owners located on West Main St. in March. At that time they had responded and indicated that they wanted to correct the problem, but the Commission directed them to file a wetland application and urged them to hold off on any activity until the weather dried up to avoid damage to the wetlands during the higher water period. Now, two of them have submitted a detailed response to correct the problem – which is simply to remove the debris blocking the drainage to the catch basin on the adjacent property. They would like to briefly present their proposal and secure permission to proceed on corrective action.
