Don MacNeil, North Windham

Mr. MacNeil asked questions about zones and how the Rt. 195 Express is funded. He expressed concern that UCONN staff members will not be able to get home from work once Rt. 195 Express ends. He supports the proposal for free rides for persons 60 years of age and over.

Ursula Roskoski, Willimantic

Ms. Roskoski inquired about the funding source for Route 32 Commuter Bus. She would like to see more service and later service. She inquired about the possibility of implementing a fare subscription service for the Route 195 Express service.

R. Kurcinik reported that these fares will probably go into effect July 1, will streamline passes, and will help fund WRTD's deficit.
