The student has therefore committed an expellable offense. Moved further that the student who is the subject of this hearing be expelled from the Windham Public Schools for a period of 180 days. During this time, the student shall not be permitted on school grounds or permitted to attend any school function. During this time, the student who is the subject of the proceeding shall receive an alternative education program as recommended through a Planning and Placement Team and provided by the administration.
