

Windham Historic District Commission Meeting

The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:40 pm.

Janet Clapp presented an application to demolish and replace a barn at 67 North Road, Property 61. The barn is deteriorated beyond repair. Photographs showing rotting sills and a hole in the roof were offered as evidence. Ms, Clapp plans to eventually construct another structure on the same site. At this point, she seeks only the Commission's approval for the demolition. She will return to the Commission for approval of the new structure.

Susan Herrick moved that the Commission approve the demolition of the barn at 67 North Road. Charlie Thorpe seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
