

MINUTES
ETHICS COMMISSION

TOWN OF WINDHAM
REGULAR MEETING

November 10, 2016

Present: Mike Sikoski, Chairman; John McGrath, Secretary; Peter Hughes;

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 P.M. at the Windham Town Hall, second floor conferenceroom.

A quorum was present at the meeting.

The citizens and delegations in attendance were offered the opportunity to speak. They were permitted to participate in the discussion which later took place concerning an ethics complaint on file with the commission.

The minutes of the September 8, 2016 regular meeting were approved with the correction noted that in the last paragraph of the minutes as presented the term “complaintant” should have read “respondent”.

Correspondence was received from the town clerk’s office requesting that the commission set its regular meeting dates for the year 2017 and submit that schedule to the town clerk’s office by December 31st.

There was no new business or new complaints received since the last meeting.

A motion was made by Mr. Sikoski to go into executive session to continue the preliminary discussion of the complaint received by the commission at its September meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Hughes and was approved by a 2 to 1 vote. Mr. McGrath voted in the negative.

Mr. McGrath reiterated his position that he is recusing himself from the substantive discussion of that complaint. The complaint remains at a confidential level pending the outcome of the preliminary investigation.

The commission came out of executive session at 9:25 pm.

The next regular meeting is scheduled for December 8th, 2016.

The commission will explore the possibility of having a special meeting to continue the preliminary discussion of the complaint on file.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
