## Minutes of meeting of Dec. 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011

### Windham High School Media Center

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:04PM. In attendance were Douglas Lary, John McCommas, and Kessenia Gagnon.
2. Citizens/Delegations  
Henry Crane, of Windham St., Willimantic, stated that upon reading the agenda, was grateful for the opportunity to comment at the end of the meeting, as the Town Council is currently no longer allowing a citizen/delegation to be heard twice during a meeting.
3. The minutes of meeting dated 10/13/11 were approved.
4. We have been waiting for several months to present the revised Code of Ethics to the admin/finance sub-committee. There has been no communication from Town Council/ Town Hall for months in trying to get the revised edition approved.
