

**WILLIMANTIC TRAFFIC AUTHORITY
MEETING
MINUTES**

DATE: March 23, 2010

Time: 2:00 pm.

Place: Main meeting room, Windham Town Hall, 979 Main Street, Willimantic, CT.

Chairman, Joe Gardner called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm. Present were the Public Works Superintendent Brad Wojick and Chief of Police Lisa Maruso-Bolduc.

Citizens and Delegations: Jeff Viens asked if overnight guests were allowed to park in residential signed areas. Joe Gardner responded yes. Mr. Viens asked if there was a cost to obtain placards. Joe Gardner responded there was none. Chief Bolduc explained under proposed budget the parking monitor was to be eliminated there would be no day to day enforcement.

Approval of Minutes from May 14, 2009 A motion was made by Brad Wojick seconded by Lisa Maruso-Bolduc to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Request for Resident Parking Signs 194 North Street on Both North and Summit Streets. A motion was made by Brad Wojick seconded by Lisa Maruso-Bolduc to install the signs. The motion passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Request for Resident Parking Only Signs 193 Prospect Street Brad Wojick made a motion to install the signs on Chestnut Street only. The motion was seconded by Chief Maruso-Bolduc and passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Request for Resident Parking Only Signs 211 North Street. Mr. Finnegan Augusta explained problem of cars being left for weeks at a time. A motion was made by Chief Maruso-Bolduc to install the signs. The motion was seconded by Brad Wojick and passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Request for Temporary Parking on High Street on March 28, 2010. A motion was made by Brad Wojick to approve the parking which is an annual request for a coin show. The motion was seconded by Chief Maruso-Bolduc and passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Temporary Speed Humps on South Ridge Drive. This was a carry over from last meeting. Public Works had bought three portable speed humps. The State Traffic Commission had been contacted and said entire road would need to be posted for rated speed of humps, which was 15 mph. All signs would need to be changed to 15 mph. A motion was made by Brad Wojick seconded by Lisa Maruso-Bolduc to install portable speed humps on South Ridge Drive as a test for a three

month period. The Town engineer is to send letter to residents notifying them. Installation will be in May. The motion passed unanimously
