

**WILLIMANTIC TRAFFIC AUTHORITY  
SPECIAL MEETING  
MINUTES**

DATE: September 26, 2013

Time: 10:00 am.

Place: First floor Meeting room, Windham Town Hall, 979 Main Street, Willimantic, CT.

Chairman, Joe Gardner, Town Engineer called the meeting to order at 10:00 am. Present were the Public Works Superintendent Brad Wojick and Chief of Police Lisa Maruzo-Bolduc.

Citizens and Delegations: Bernard D'Auteuil stated relief from ECSU students is needed in the hill section. He would like parking on one side of streets. Lisa Maruzo-Bolduc would like to look at one side of street parking on Walnut and Valley. She requested Town Engineer send letters to property owners on Walnut Street between Valley and Prospect Streets regarding their opinion on one side of street parking.

Approval of Minutes from November 12, 2012

A motion was made by Lisa Maruzo-Bolduc to approve the minutes as submitted. The motion was seconded by Brad Wojick and passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Posting Victory Lane with a full size "Not a Through Street" Sign

Brad Wojick stated the existing sign was adequate. A motion was made by Lisa Maruzo-Bolduc to leave the sign as is. The motion was seconded by Brad Wojick and passed unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Request from ECSU to Remove "No Parking" Signs by 333 Windham Street.

Brad Wojick reported he had taken the signs down

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the North Street/Ash Street Intersection

Chief Lisa Maruzo-Bolduc reported there was only one accident in last 18 months. Brad Wojick reported that he had painted stop bars and trimmed bushes. No action was taken.

Discussion and Possible Action regarding Handicapped Parking by the Library and a Handicapped Loading Zone by the Proposed Path Academy.

It was discussed that there is a shortage of parking on Main Street and that there are handicapped parking areas in the two municipal lots nearby. A motion was made by Brad Wojick seconded by Lisa Maruzo-Bolduc to not support any additional handicapped parking or loading zones on Main Street.

Adjournment

A motion was made by Chief Maruzo-Bolduc to adjourn at 10:20 am. The motion was seconded by Brad Wojick and passed unanimously.
