

Windham Historic District Commission Meeting
July 25, 2007

The Public Hearing was called to order at 7:35 pm.

Andrew Gibson presented an application to build a short (two-course) stone wall along the front of the property at 10 Windham Center Road (Property 10). The proposed wall will run along the line of a fence that previously stood in front of the property as shown in a 19th-century photograph of the house. The Gibsons intend to reconstruct the fence at some future time. The stone wall being constructed now will provide the footings for the future fence.

The Public Hearing was closed and the Commission Meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm.

Charlie Thorpe moved to approve the Gibsons' application; Susan Herrick seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.

The minutes of the previous meeting were circulated and approved.

There was no other business requiring the Commissioners attention.
